Small Groups are not "another thing" at Cornerstone; they are one of the main channels for discipleship and care for each person who is a part of the Cornerstone family.

Most **Small Groups** meet every other week and are led by a trained **Small Group** leader. Group meetings are normally two hours and include time for Bible discussion, accountability, and prayer, as well as informal times to build relationships with others in the group.
